

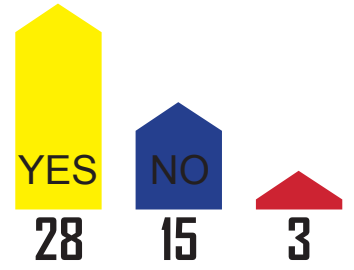


Venezuela

Sanctions Imposed by Obama, Trump, Canada and EU ¹



On March 23, 2018, the Human Rights council voted to “condemn unilateral coercive measures” ²



They voted against these sanctions because they cause:

- DEATH
- NO ACCESS TO MEDICINE
- CRIME
- FOOD
- ECONOMIC CRISIS
- FORCED MIGRATION
- VIOLENCE

Sanctions are considered crimes against humanity, according to ARTICLE 7 of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court ³

Military Occupation

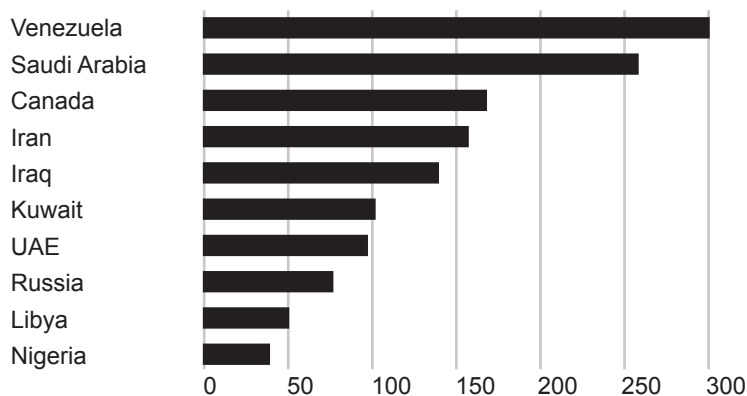
Currently, there are 800 US bases world wide.⁵ 76 are located in Latin America ⁶

- 8 PERU
- 35 CENTRAL AMERICA & THE CARIBBEAN

Mexico, Nicaragua, Argentina, Brazil, Uruguay, Paraguay, Venezuela & Bolivia

Oil The proven oil reserves in Venezuela are recognized as the largest in the world, totaling 297 billion barrels (4.72×10¹⁰ m³) as of 1 January 2014.⁷
